SOUTHEAST ALASKA SUMMER TROLL FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The department provides the following information detailing the status of commercial salmon trolling in waters that occur within the Deep Inlet Terminal Harvest Area (THA). The Deep Inlet THA closed to terminal rotational fisheries for the season on September 20, however, from September 21 through the end of the summer troll season, the waters of Deep Inlet are managed under traditional summer troll fishery regulations and remain open. The summer troll fishery will close at 11:59 p.m., Monday, September 30, 2024, as described in the advisory announcement issued September 16, 2024.

As specified under 5 AAC 39.290(a)(2), waters within 500 yards of the fresh water of a salmon stream are closed to commercial salmon fishing, and these restrictions apply under traditional fishery management for those waters within Deep Inlet from September 21–30.

All harvest from the waters within Deep Inlet from September 21–30 should be reported as statistical area 113-41 on salmon troll fish tickets.
