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**2024/25 SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SEA CUCUMBER FISHERY
ANNOUNCEMENT**

The following areas will be closed for the remainder of the 2024/25 season:

District 1

Tree Point (Subdistricts 101-10 and 11);
Percy Islands (Subdistrict 101-25).

The following areas will be open from **8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday, November 4, 2024, and from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, Tuesday, November 5, 2024:**

District 1

West Behm Canal (Subdistricts 101-90 and 95);

District 2

Lower Clarence Strait (Subdistrict 102-20);
Kasaan Bay and Skowl Arm (Subdistrict 102-60);
Cleveland Peninsula (Subdistrict 102-80);

District 3

Hetta Inlet, Nutkwa Inlet, and Keete Inlet (Subdistricts 103-23 and 25);
Trocadero Bay (Subdistrict 103-60);

District 6

Snow Pass (Subdistrict 106-30);

District 12

Chatham Strait and Kelp Bay (Subdistricts 112-11, 21, and 22);
Eastern portion of Tenakee Inlet (Subdistricts 112-41 and 42);
Western portion of Tenakee Inlet (Subdistricts 112-43, 44, 45, 46, 47, and 48);

District 13

Salisbury Sound and Peril Strait (Subdistricts 113-62, 63, 64, 65, and 66).

Fishers and processors are reminded that an accurate fish ticket is required at the time of delivery. A fish ticket must be filled out according to 5 AAC 39.130(c). Fishers must verify at the time of landing with the tender or processor that all information is accurate before signing the fish ticket, including statistical area, pounds of sea cucumbers harvested, and any overages.

For a description of the above areas, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial sea cucumber fishery announcement dated August 28, 2024, announcing the open areas and their guideline harvest levels (GHLs). The next advisory announcement following this opening will be available on **Thursday, November 7, 2024**.
