**2024/25 SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SEA CUCUMBER FISHERY
SUMMARY**

The 2024/25 Southeast Alaska sea cucumber fishery **closed by regulation Monday, March 31, 2025**. The fishery opened on October 7, 2024, with a total guideline harvest level (GHL) of 1,759,900 pounds of sea cucumbers. The fishery was opened weekly throughout the entire season, except for the final partial week. The 2024/25 season's harvest of 1,753,900 pounds was 0.3% under the total GHL. A total of 160 divers participated and made 1,369 landings. The maximum number of divers that participated in any single opening was 149 during the first and second openings of the season. The exvessel value for the season was approximately \$8.7 million, with an average price of \$4.90 per pound.
