Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #13 **Emergency Order 12**

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District. The time is 3:00 p.m. and the date is Wednesday, June 25.

On June 24, the Naknek River escapement was 18,000 sockeye. From midnight to 2:00 p.m. today the count was 6,000 for a total escapement of 83,000. The Kvichak River total escapement is 5,000 sockeye.

The Kvichak Section will open to drift gillnet gear for a 6-hour period from 1:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Thursday, June 26. The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to set gillnet gear for a 6-hour period from 1:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Thursday, June 26.

Permit holders are reminded that all king salmon caught must be reported on a fish ticket at the time of delivery. Permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand by at regularly scheduled announcement times and be prepared for fishing periods on short notice.
