

Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #31 Emergency Order 37

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Friday, the 4th of July.

On July 3, the Naknek River escapement was 17,000 sockeye for a total of 600,000; the Alagnak River escapement was 214,000 sockeye for a total of 872,000; and the Kvichak River escapement was 490,000 sockeye for a total of 1 million. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 800,000 fish. The harvest on July 3 was an estimated 400,000 fish for a total of 3.3 million. There are 256 vessels registered to fish in the district and there will be 300 in 48 hours. The harvest percentage is 62% drift, 20% Naknek set, and 18% Kvichak set.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for a 7.5-hour period from 9:00 p.m. Friday, July 4 until 4:30 a.m. Saturday, July 5 and again for a 7-hour period from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Saturday, July 5. The Naknek-Kvichak District will close to set gillnet gear at 2:30 p.m. Friday, July 4. The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to set gillnet gear for a 7-hour period from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Saturday, July 5.

Permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand by at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, July 5 for the next possible announcement.
