

Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #36 Emergency Orders 44, 45

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak and Ugashik districts. The time is 12:00 p.m. and the date is Sunday, July 6.

Naknek-Kvichak District

On July 5, the Naknek River escapement was 56,000 sockeye for a total of 660,000; the Alagnak River escapement was 38,000 for a total of 1 million; and the Kvichak River escapement was 328,000 for a total of 1.8 million. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 800,000 fish. The harvest on July 5 was 917,000 fish for a total of 4.8 million.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for an 18-hour period from 10:00 p.m. Sunday, July 6 until 4:00 p.m. Monday, July 7. The Naknek-Kvichak District is open set gillnet gear until further notice.

Ugashik District

Ugashik River escapement through July 5 is 204,000 sockeye. The inriver estimate is 100,000 fish. Harvest from July 5 was 291,000, bringing the season total to 2.3 million fish. There are 159 vessels currently registered in the district.

The Ugashik District will open to commercial fishing with drift gillnet gear for 8 hours from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday, July 7. Commercial fishing with set gillnet gear will open for 12 hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday, July 7.

Permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak and Ugashik districts should stand by at 12:00 noon Monday, July 7 for the next possible announcement.
