BURNETT INLET TERMINAL HARVEST AREA TROLL FISHERY

The Burnett Inlet Terminal Harvest Area (THA) commercial salmon troll fishery will open for the harvest of chum, coho, sockeye, and pink salmon from 12:01 a.m., Monday, July 7, 2025, until closed by emergency order to allow for broodstock collection. The THA will not open to common property commercial net gear during the 2025 season.

The Burnett Inlet THA (**statistical area 106-25**) consists of the waters of Burnett Inlet north of 56°04.65′ N lat. The Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association is forecasting a return of approximately 693,000 hatchery-produced summer chum salmon and 23,800 hatchery-produced fall chum salmon to the Burnett Inlet THA. Trollers are advised that cost-recovery operations may be conducted at times within the THA.

Statistical area 106-25 should be recorded on fish tickets for harvest within the Burnett Inlet THA.

<u>Chinook Salmon Landing Restrictions for Burnett Inlet THA</u>: Chinook salmon retention is permitted only during general summer troll Chinook salmon retention periods established under 5 AAC 29.100.
