## **Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #38**

Emergency Orders 47, 48, 49

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak, Egegik, and Ugashik districts. The time is 12:00 noon and the date is Monday, July 7.

### Naknek-Kvichak District

On July 6, the Naknek River escapement was 45,000 sockeye for a total of 705,000; the Alagnak River escapement was 72,000 for a total of 1.1 million; and the Kvichak River escapement was 116,000 for a total of 2 million, which is within the escapement goal. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 500,000 fish. The harvest on July 6 was 426,000 fish for a total of 5.3 million.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for a 17.5-hour period from 11:00 p.m. Monday, July 7 until 4:30 p.m. Tuesday, July 8. The Naknek-Kvichak District is open set gillnet gear until further notice.

### **Egegik District**

Fishing with set gillnets in the Egegik District is extended until further notice.

#### **Ugashik District**

Ugashik River escapement through July 6 is 249,000 sockeye. The inriver estimate is 200,000 fish. Harvest from July 6 was 252,000, bringing the season total to 2.5 million fish.

The Ugashik District will open to commercial fishing with drift gillnet gear for 8 hours from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 8. Commercial fishing with set gillnet gear will open for 12 hours from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 8.

Permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak and Ugashik districts should stand by at 12:00 noon Tuesday, July 8 for the next possible announcement.
