This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Tuesday, July 15.

On July 14, the Naknek River escapement was 14,000 sockeye for a total of 970,000; the Alagnak River escapement was 38,000 for a total of 1.9 million; and the Kvichak River escapement was 60,000 for a total of 2.8 million. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 80,000 fish. The harvest on July 14 was an estimated 400,000 fish for a total of 10.6 million.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for a 5.5-hour period from 5:00 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. Tuesday, July 15 and again for a 7-hour period from 5:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 16. The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to set gillnet gear for a 19-hour period from 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 15 until 12:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 16.

Permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand by at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 16 for the next announcement.
