KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #47 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-47-25

There will be a <u>48-hour extension</u> to the current commercial salmon fishing period from 6:00 p.m. Saturday, September 6, until 6:00 p.m. Monday, September 8, in the following areas:

- The Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections of the Alitak District;
- The Southeast Afognak, Northwest Afognak, Northeast Afognak, Perenosa Bay, Pauls Bay, and Shuyak Island Sections of the Afognak District;
- The Wide Bay, Cape Igvak, Alinchak Bay, and Katmai Sections of the Mainland District; and
- The Outer Ayakulik Section of the Southwest Kodiak District.

Closed Waters Adjustments:

Closed waters will be reduced from noon Saturday, September 6 until 6:00 p.m. Sunday, September 7 in the Inner Kitoi Bay Section, to the ADF&G markers deployed by hatchery staff located in Big Kitoi and Little Kitoi Bays (near stream #s 252-324 and 252-323).

As Previously Announced:

There will be a <u>30-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Saturday**, **September 6** until **6:00 p.m. Sunday**, **September 7** in the **Inner Kitoi Bay Section** of the **Afognak District**.

The Outer Kitoi Bay Section and the Izhut Bay Section north of a line from Haystack Rock (at 58° 10.58' N lat., 152° 17.36' W long.) to Pillar Cape (at 58° 08.90' N lat., 152° 06.77' W long.) of the Afognak District will open to commercial salmon fishing beginning at noon Saturday, September 6 and remain open until further notice.

The **Izhut Bay Section** (south of a line from Haystack Rock to Pillar Cape) of the **Afognak District** <u>remains</u> <u>closed</u> to commercial salmon fishing <u>until further notice.</u>

The following areas **remain open** to commercial salmon fishing **until further notice**:

- The Duck Bay Section of the Afognak District;
- The Humpy-Deadman Section of the Alitak District;
- The Northeast Kodiak District; and
- The Eastside Kodiak District.

Fishermen are reminded that in the Kodiak Area (including the Mainland District) until further notice, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office.
