KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #48 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-48-25

The Izhut Bay Section south of a line from Haystack Rock (at 58° 10.58' N lat., 152° 17.36' W long.) to Pillar Cape (at 58° 08.90' N lat., 152° 06.77' W long.) of the Afognak District will open to commercial salmon fishing beginning at noon Tuesday, September 9 and remain open until further notice.

The following areas will close to commercial salmon fishing beginning at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 9:

- The Humpy-Deadman Section of the Alitak District;
- The Northeast Kodiak District; and
- The Eastside Kodiak District.

As Previously Announced:

The following areas will close to commercial salmon fishing at 6:00 p.m. Monday, September 8:

- The Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections of the Alitak District;
- The Southeast Afognak, Northwest Afognak, Northeast Afognak, Perenosa Bay, Pauls Bay, and Shuvak Island Sections of the Afognak District;
- The Wide Bay, Cape Igvak, Alinchak Bay, and Katmai Sections of the Mainland District; and
- The Outer Avakulik Section of the Southwest Kodiak District.

The following areas **remain open** to commercial salmon fishing **until further notice**:

- The **Duck Bay**, **Outer Kitoi Bay**, and **Izhut Bay Sections** (north of Haystack Rock to Pillar Cape) of the **Afognak District**.

Fishermen are reminded that in the Kodiak Area (including the Mainland District) until further notice, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office.
