**BURNETT INLET TERMINAL HARVEST AREA TROLL FISHERY**

The **Burnett Inlet Terminal Harvest Area (THA)** commercial salmon troll fishery will open for the harvest of chum, coho, sockeye, and pink salmon **from 12:01 a.m., Saturday, June 27, 2026**, until closed by emergency order. The Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association is forecasting a total return of approximately 426,000 hatchery-produced summer chum salmon and 11,600 hatchery-produced fall chum salmon to the Burnett Inlet THA.

The Burnett Inlet THA (**statistical area 106-25**) consists of the waters of Burnett Inlet north of 56°04.65' N lat. **Statistical area 106-25 should be recorded on fish tickets** for harvest within the Burnett Inlet THA.

**Chinook Salmon Landing Restrictions for Burnett Inlet THA:** Chinook salmon retention is permitted only during general summer troll Chinook salmon retention periods established under 5 AAC 29.100.
