Closure of the Kodiak Management Area Parallel Pacific Cod Jig Gear Season and Opening of the State-Waters Pacific Cod Jig Gear Season

Emergency Order 4-GF-05-14

By regulation, if the Central Gulf of Alaska (CGOA) federal/parallel A-season for jig gear has not closed by March 15, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) shall close the parallel (0 to 3 nautical miles) CGOA jig gear season in the Kodiak Management Area and open the Kodiak Management Area state-waters jig gear season to facilitate harvest of the state-waters Pacific cod guideline harvest level (GHL). Through March 9, 2014 approximately 77 percent of the federal/parallel CGOA A-season jig gear allocation remains unharvested. Therefore, the Kodiak Area parallel Pacific cod jig gear season will close and the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod jig gear season will immediately reopen at NOON Saturday March 15, 2014.

Vessel operators currently participating in the parallel CGOA Pacific cod jig season must deliver all catch prior to targeting Pacific cod during the state-waters season. While the Kodiak Area state-waters (0 to 3 nmi) jig gear season and the federal (3 to 200 nmi) CGOA jig gear seasons are open concurrently:

- A vessel may not participate in the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod jig season and any other Pacific cod season at the same time.
- Vessel operators must invalidate their state-waters vessel registration if switching from the Kodiak Area state-waters jig fishery to any other Pacific cod fishery.
- Vessel operators must deliver all catch prior to changing a state-waters Pacific cod vessel registration.
- A state-waters vessel registration may be validated or invalidated by contacting ADF&G in Kodiak during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday Friday).

The 2014 Kodiak Area state-waters jig gear GHL allocation is 7.32 million pounds. Prior to participating in the state-waters jig fishery, vessel operators are required to obtain an exclusive state-waters Pacific cod vessel registration from ADF&G.
