SHORT TERM VESSEL CHARTER FOR THE CHIGNIK WEIR

The Alaska Department of Fish & Game will be soliciting bids for a vessel and crew to transport equipment, timber pilings, fuel, and supplies from Chignik Bay (Anchorage Bay) to the Chignik weir. The charter will start at a specified dock in Chignik Bay and end at the ADF&G Chignik weir. This charter will start as early as May 12, 2014 and must be concluded by May 17, 2014. All equipment, pilings, fuel, and supplies will be transferred from an ADF&G vessel onto the chartered vessel(s) in Chignik Bay on approximately May 14, 2014. The chartered vessel(s) will be required to navigate through the Chignik Lagoon and into the Chignik River up to the Chignik weir. The transported equipment, pilings, fuel, and supplies will be off loaded at the Chignik weir bulkhead no later than the 6:00 a.m. high tide the morning of Saturday, May 17, 2014. **The bidding process must be completed by 5:00 p.m. Friday, April 18, 2014.**

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Short Term Vessel Charter for the Chignik Weir

Bidders Responsibility:

1. Provide a vessel of not less than 30 feet.
2. Provide a means of offloading all materials, supplies, pilings, and fuel at point of delivery (Chignik weir).
3. Provide experienced captain and crew to safely run vessel. Boat crew will load and offload all materials, supplies, pilings, and fuel.
4. Provide all fuel, lubricants, and required supplies to operate the vessel for duration of charter.
6. Make captain and crew available during all phases of the vessel charter.
7. Submit to Coast Guard inspection at the discretion of the Department.
8. Provide proof of insurance to the State of Alaska.

Some examples of materials, supplies, pilings, and fuel to be transported on chartered vessel.

- Sixteen 25' timber pilings (can be floated)
- Twenty pallets of miscellaneous food/gear
- 400 gallons of unleaded gasoline (to be transferred from vessel's tanks)
- 1,800 to 2,000 gallons of diesel fuel (to be transferred from vessel's tanks)
- Forty-four 55 gallon drums of AV Gas
- Two 55 gallon drums of miscellaneous petroleum products
