BERING SEA KING AND TANNER CRAB SEASON ANNOUNCEMENTS

Announcement of harvest levels for Bristol Bay red king crab, St. Matthew Island Section blue king crab, and Bering Sea District snow and Tanner crab will occur on or after October 6; delay of announcements for those fisheries does not guarantee an opening.

Pribilof District Red and Blue King Crab Seasons Closed

Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) and National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) have completed analysis of 2014 NMFS trawl survey results for Pribilof District red and blue king crabs. Pribilof District red and blue king crab fisheries will remain closed for the 2014/15 season.

The 2014 area-swept estimate for Pribilof District blue king crab indicate continued very-low abundance, remaining well below the minimum stock size threshold (MSST). Pribilof District blue king crab must meet a minimum threshold of 13.2 million pounds of total mature biomass (TMB) in two consecutive years for the fishery to open. Both the 2013 and 2014 estimates of TMB are well below this threshold; therefore, the fishery will remain closed.

There is considerable uncertainty surrounding precision of Pribilof District red king crab abundance estimates. Given the high uncertainty surrounding the red king crab abundance estimate and high potential for blue king crab bycatch mortality during a red king crab fishery, the Pribilof District red king crab fishery will remain closed.
