SOUTHEAST ALASKA GEODUCK CLAM FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

Ketchikan. . . The Alaska Department of Fish and Game announced today the following information regarding the Southeast Alaska commercial geoduck clam fishery.

The following areas will be open for the commercial harvest of geoduck clams for live sale from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, Thursday, December 4, 2014:

<u>Vegas and Hotspur Islands (Subdistrict 101-25-003)</u>: will be open for a remaining harvest of 52,000 pounds of whole geoduck clams;

St. Nicholas Channel, North Lulu Island (Subdistrict 103-70-007): will be open for a remaining harvest of 68,000 pounds of whole geoduck clams;

<u>Cone Island North (Subdistricts 103-50-005, 104-40-005)</u>: will be open for a GHL of 68,200 pounds of whole geoduck clams;

<u>Cone Island South and Paloma Pass (Subdistricts 103-50-006, 104-35-006)</u>: will be open for a GHL of 55,300 pounds of whole geoduck clams.

The following areas will be open for the commercial harvest of geoduck clams for live sale from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Thursday, December 4, 2014:

<u>Cat and Dog Islands (Subdistricts 101-23-005, 101-41-005)</u>: will be open for a remaining harvest of 30,000 pounds of whole geoduck clams;

<u>Port Santa Cruz (Subdistrict 104-30-002)</u>: will be open for a remaining harvest of 45,000 pounds of whole geoduck clams.

By regulation, all geoducks harvested must be clearly labeled with the date of harvest, the harvester's name, and the location of harvest. In order to facilitate weekly sampling schedules the Alaska Department of Fish and Game must receive timely information about the daily harvest by area. Divers are requested to contact the company buying their geoduck clams with an estimate of pounds harvested. All companies buying geoduck clams are requested to contact the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, Division of Commercial Fisheries, Ketchikan office before 12:00 noon on Friday, December 5, with a harvest estimate by area.
