DISTRICT 15 DRIFT GILLNET FISHERY EXTENSION CORRECTION

Haines. . . The Alaska Department of Fish and Game announced today a correction to the drift gillnet fishery extension announcement issued on July 28, 2015 for District 15. The northern line description in Chilkat Inlet is incorrect and is corrected as follows:

Section 15-A: will be extended for 24 hours and will close at 12:00 noon, Thursday, July 30 in the waters of Lynn Canal south of the latitude of Seduction Point, with the following restriction:

Chilkat Inlet: will be closed north of the latitude of the northernmost tip of Kochu Island at 59°09.03' N. latitude.

Section 15-A will also open from 12:00 noon, Wednesday, July 29, through 12:00 noon, Thursday, July 30, south of the latitude of Mud Bay Point.

Section 15-C: will be extended for 24 hours and will close at 12:00 noon, Thursday, July 30, with the following restriction:

Endicott River: Section 15-C will be closed within two nautical miles of the western shoreline of Lynn Canal between Danger Point at 58°41.73' N. latitude and Sherman Rock at 58°51.30' N. latitude.

Section 15-C: The Boat Harbor Terminal Harvest Area will be open until further notice in those waters within two nautical miles of the western shoreline of Lynn Canal from the latitude of Danger Point at 58°41.73' N. latitude and south to a point 2.4 miles north of Point Whidbey at 58°36.96' N. latitude.
