2015 Kuskokwim River Salmon Fishery News Release #19 Emergency Order #3-S-WR-29-15

This is an announcement from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in Bethel for Kuskokwim Area fishermen.

Subdistrict 1-B

The Upper Section of Subdistrict 1-B will open to commercial salmon fishing for 6 hours from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. Friday, August 20, 2015. This area is defined as that portion of District 1 downstream of regulatory markers located at Bethel to ADF&G regulatory markers located approximately 15 miles downstream of Johnson River.

The Lower Section of Subdistrict 1-B will open to commercial salmon fishing for 8 hours from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Friday, August 20, 2015. This area is defined as that portion of District 1 from a line between ADF&G regulatory markers located approximately 15 miles downstream of the Johnson River to the lower boundary of District 1, defined as a line from Apokak Slough to the southernmost tip of Eek Island to Popokamiut.

The hours for subsistence closures adjacent to periods of commercial fishing on the Kuskokwim River are 6 hours before, during, and 3 hours after commercial fishing. The area closed to subsistence fishing includes the subdistrict open to commercial fishing and a buffer area of the adjacent subdistrict. Therefore, from 4:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. Friday, August 20, subsistence salmon fishing in the Kuskokwim River will be closed from the upper end of Straight Slough downstream to a line from Apokak Slough to the southern-most tip of Eek Island to Popokamiut.

Further announcements will be made from the Bethel Fish and Game office, on the State of Alaska web site (http://www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=cfnews.main), and local radio stations. News releases will be faxed to area villages and local fish processing companies.
