2016 Yukon River Fall Salmon Fishery News Release # 15 Yukon River District 1 Commercial Period 6

Districts Affected: Lower Yukon Area Emergency Order # 16

The 2016 fall chum salmon preseason run projection, based on the summer chum to fall chum salmon relationship, is for a run size between 800,000 and 900,000 fish. This level of abundance should be sufficient to provide for escapement, an above average subsistence harvest, and a surplus available for commercial and personal use purposes. The estimated fall chum salmon passage at the mainstem sonar near Pilot Station through July 30 is 365,900 fish, which is above the historical median of 149,600 fish for that date.

District 1 Commercial Fishing:

Commercial fishing will be open for one period in the <u>Set Net Only Area</u> of District Y-1 on Monday, August 1 from 1:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. This will be a 9-hour commercial fishing period for the <u>Set Net Only Area</u> with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh.

The remainder of District Y-1 will be open to commercial fishing on Monday, August 1 from 4:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. This will be a 6-hour commercial fishing period with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh.

District 1 Subsistence Fishing:

Subsistence salmon fishing in District 1 is open during the fall season 7 days per week, 24 hours per day with gillnets restricted to a maximum mesh size of 7.5 inches, except for 12 hours before, during, and 12 hours after each commercial fishing period. In District 1, subsistence salmon fishing will close at 1:00 a.m. Monday, August 1, and reopen at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday,

August 2. Fishermen may use 4-inch or smaller mesh size gillnets to target non-salmon species during subsistence salmon closures.
