# SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL BEAM TRAWL SHRIMP FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

Douglas. . . The Alaska Department of Fish and Game today announced the following information concerning the 2016/2017 Southeast Alaska commercial beam trawl fishery.

# Guideline Harvest Levels (GHLs) for fishing period three of the 2016/2017 Season

### District 6

Three vessels participated in the District 6 fishery during the second fishing period, harvesting a total of 155,555 lb of combined pink and sidestripe shrimp (Table 1). The remaining GHL of 244,445 will be rolled over, bringing the period three GHL to the upper regulatory bound of 400,000 lb of combined pink and sidestripe shrimp (Table 2). As a reminder, the 9,000 lb bycatch limit of coonstripe shrimp was reached on September 11, 2016, thus all coonstripe shrimp caught in District 6 must be retained, sold, and the proceeds surrendered to the state in accordance with 5 AAC 31.116 (d).

### District 8

Less than three vessels participated in the District 8 fishery during the second fishing period, thus harvest is confidential (Table 1). The GHL for fishing period three will be the upper regulatory bound of 250,000 lb of combined pink and sidestripe shrimp (Table 2). A total of 1,556 lb of the bycatch allowance of spot shrimp was caught in the first two periods leaving a further 4,444 lb of bycatch allowance.
