CRAIG HERRING UPDATE 2017 # 5

An aerial and skiff surveys were conducted Sunday, March 26, in the Craig area. The weather was cloudy with high winds. ADF&G personnel are on the grounds and will be monitoring the fishery on a daily basis throughout the Craig spawning event.

One mile of spawn was observed in San Christoval Channel. One mile of spawn was observed in the northern area of San Alberto Bay by Point Ildefonso. Predator activity suggests continued spawning in both of these areas. Sea lions and whales continue to be active around Fish Egg, Clam, and the Alberto Islands.

The department estimates there are **20 closed pound structures** on the fishing grounds that will be fished. There are additional pounds that will be fished as open pounds or used as tow pounds.

The next scheduled aerial survey is for Monday, March 27.
