Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Update #13

This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in King Salmon with an update for Naknek-Kvichak District fishermen. The time is 3:00 p.m. and the date is Monday, June 26, 2017.

The Naknek River escapement on June 25 was 3,264 sockeye. The 2:00 pm. count today was 300 for a cumulative of 19,000; the Kvichak River cumulative escapement is 1,300 sockeye. District test fishing today indicated some fish are moving into the district; however these fish are needed for escapement.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand-by at 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 27.
