CHIGNIK WEIR SOCKEYE SALMON STOCK COMPOSITION SUMMARY #3 July 7-8, 2017

This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game with an update regarding genetic stock composition estimates for sockeye salmon from the Chignik River weir for July 7-8, 2017. A total of 190 fish were sampled and 190 fish were analyzed (189 had adequate data to include in the analysis).

Samples were collected at the Chignik weir and analyzed at the Gene Conservation Laboratory by Commercial Fisheries Division staff. These results are in-season estimates and are therefore preliminary in nature.
