**SAND POINT COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT # 25
For Emergency Order #4-FS-M-SP-22-17**

Commercial salmon fishing will be extended in the Unimak, Southwestern, and South Central districts, as well as, the Shumagin Islands Section of the Southeastern District for 48 hours from 12:00 p.m., August 5 until 12:00 p.m., August 7, 2017.

Commercial salmon fishing will be allowed in Beaver Bay, Balboa Bay, Southwest Stepovak, Northwest Stepovak, and East Stepovak sections of the Southeastern District for 48 hours from 12:00 p.m., August 5 until 12:00 p.m., August 7, 2017.

As previously announced:

Commercial salmon fishing will be extended in the Canoe Bay, East Pavlof Bay, and Mino Creek-Little Coal Bay sections of the South Central District from 9:30 a.m., August 2 until further notice.

All closed waters in the above locations will be as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.

Subsistence permits for the Alaska Peninsula are available in the ADF&G offices in Sand Point and Port Moller. Subsistence fishermen must obtain a permit and have it in their possession while harvesting salmon under subsistence guidelines.

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point and Port Moller Fish and Game offices.
