SOUTHEAST ALASKA SALMON PURSE SEINE FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

Sitka. . . The Alaska Department of Fish and Game announced today that the previously announced September 6 opening has been modified as described below. Lines have been added for the District 2 fall chum fishery and in addition, the department has observed a harvestable surplus of pink salmon in Klakas Inlet in District 3 that warrants an immediate fishery.

District 2

The following area will be open to purse seining from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 6, 2017:

District 2: will be open within 2 nautical miles of the Prince of Wales Island shoreline south of the northernmost tip of Tolstoi Point at 55°40.25′ N. latitude and **north of the latitude of Cape Chacon Light** with the following restrictions:

<u>Cholmondeley Sound</u>: will be closed south of a line from approximately **0.8 nautical miles east of Hump Island at 55°13.49′ N. latitude**, **132°05.26′ W. longitude** to the westernmost tip of Hump Island at 55°13.62′ N. latitude to a point 1 nautical mile due west of the northernmost tip of Babe Island at 55°13.04′ N. latitude, 132°09.64′ W. longitude;

West Arm of Cholmondeley Sound: will be closed west of 132°20.05′ W. Longitude;

South Arm of Cholmondeley Sound: will be closed south of 55°12.00′ N. latitude;

<u>Kasaan Bay, Skowl Arm, Twelve Mile Arm, and contiguous waters</u>: will be closed west of Island Point at 132°10.00′ W. longitude;

<u>Moira Sound</u>: will be closed west of the easternmost entrance of Menefee Anchorage at 132°00.35′ W. longitude;

Sunny Cove: will be closed north of 55°15.00′ N. latitude;

Thorne Bay, Tolstoi Bay, and contiguous waters: will be closed.

District 3

The following area will be open to purse seining from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 6, 2017:

Section 3-A: will be open in the following area:

<u>Klakas Inlet</u>: will be open north of a point near Ruth Cutoff at 54°54.40′ N. latitude, 132°24.77′ W. longitude and south of 55°03.78′ N. latitude approximately 0.9 nautical miles south of the head of the inlet.

The next seine announcement will be issued on Monday, September 11, 2017.
