YAKUTAT COMMERCIAL SET GILLNET OPENING ANNOUNCEMENT

Yakutat...The Alaska Department of Fish and Game today announced the following information concerning the Yakutat Area commercial set gillnet fishery.

<u>Alsek River</u>: will be open from 12:01 p.m., Sunday, June 24, through 12:00 noon, Monday, June 25. Until further notice, salmon may be taken only with gillnets of six inches or smaller mesh.

East River: will remain **closed** until further notice. This includes the waters two miles on either side of the mouth seaward for a distance of 500 yards.

Dangerous River: will be open from 6:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, through 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 25.

<u>Akwe River</u>: will remain closed until further notice and may open on short notice once escapement counts have improved.

Lost River: will remain closed until further notice.

<u>Situk-Ahrnklin Inlet</u>: will be open from 6:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, through 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 25, with the following restrictions:

Mouth of Situk River: commercial set gillnet fishing is prohibited near the mouth of the Situk River west of a line from an ADF&G regulation marker located at the southeast end of Johnson Slough (59°26.27' N. latitude, 139°32.62' W. longitude) to a regulation marker directly across the Inlet on Black Sand Spit (59°25.77' N. latitude, 139°33.18' W. longitude) to a regulation marker westward along the beach of Black Sand Spit (59°26.49' N. latitude, 139°35.01' W. longitude) and to a regulation marker west of the Yakutat Seafoods buying station (59°26.72' N. latitude, 139°34.61' W. longitude). **All waters of Johnson Slough are closed** to commercial fishing until the Chinook salmon run is over.

Mouth of the Lost River: commercial set gillnet fishing is prohibited near the mouth of the Lost River west of a line from an ADF&G regulation marker located at 59°27.38' N. latitude, 139°36.55' W. longitude (approximately 500 yards upstream from the Lost River-Situk Inlet confluence) to a regulation marker directly across the Inlet on Black Sand Spit at 59°27.13' N. latitude, 139°36.83' W. longitude, to a regulation marker westward along the beach of Black Sand

Spit at 59°27.63' N. latitude, 139°37.80' W. longitude, to a regulation marker approximately 600 yards west of the Lost River mouth at 59°27.82' N. latitude, 139°37.46' W. longitude.

Yakutat Bay: will be open from 6:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, through 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 25.

Manby Shore-Outside Waters: will be open from 6:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, through 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 25.

Manby Shore-Inside Waters: will be open from 6:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, through 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 25.

<u>Remainder of the Yakutat District</u>: will be open from 6:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, through 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 25.
