**KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT #29  
For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-29-18**

The **Izhut Bay Section** of the **Afognak District** will **close** to commercial salmon fishing at **9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 9.**

The **Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area** (Telrod Cove) will **close** to commercial salmon fishing at **9:00 p.m. Friday, August 10.**

The **Dog Salmon Flats Section** of the **Alitak District** will be **extended** to commercial salmon fishing **until further notice** beginning at **9:00 p.m. Friday, August 10.**

**Closed Water Adjustments:**

Closed waters are reduced **until further notice** in the following areas of the **Dog Salmon Flats Section:**

- To the ADF&G markers located at the stream termini of **Dog Salmon Creek** (stream #257-403); and,
- To the ADF&G markers located near **Horse Marine Lagoon** (stream #257-402).

**As Previously Announced:**

The **Inner Kitoi and Outer Kitoi Bay section** of the **Afognak District** **will open** to commercial salmon fishing for **9 hours** when a flare is launched by hatchery staff at approximately **noon Thursday, August 9 to 9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 9.**

The will be a **9-hour** commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Thursday, August 9 to 9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 9** in **Inner Karluk Section** of the **Southwest Kodiak District**.

The following areas will **close** as scheduled at **9:00 p.m. Friday August 10**:

- The **Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, Olga Bay** sections of the **Alitak District**.
- The **Halibut Bay, Sturgeon, and Outer Karluk** sections of the **Southwest Kodiak District**.
- The **Central, North Cape, Uyak Bay, Spiridon Bay, Inner Uganik Bay, and Anton Larsen Bay** sections of the **Northwest Kodiak District** (the Sheratin Bay, Kizhuyak Bay, Terror Bay, and Zachar Bay sections remain closed); and,
- The **Southwest Afognak Section** of the **Afognak District**.

**Closed Water Adjustments:**

**Closed waters** will be the ADF&G markers at **Little Kitoi Creek** (stream #252-323) and **increased** to the ADF&G markers placed by hatchery staff near **Big Kitoi Creek** (stream # 252-324).

Closed waters will be **reduced** in the **Inner Karluk Section** to **Karluk Lagoon's exit channel terminus at the ocean shoreline** (stream #255-101) from **noon Thursday, August 9 to 9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 9**.

**Until further notice**, in that **portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear** in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350).
