## KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT #30 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-30-18

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Monday**, August 13 to 9:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 15 in the following areas:

The Cape Alitak, Humpy-Deadman, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay sections of the Alitak District.

The **Duck Bay and Izhut Bay sections of the Afognak District** will <u>open</u> to commercial salmon fishing from **noon Monday, August 13** and remain <u>open until further notice.</u>

## As Previously Announced:

The **Dog Salmon Flats Section** of the **Alitak District** remains open to commercial salmon fishing **until further notice.** 

## **Closed Water Adjustments**:

Closed waters are reduced <u>until further notice</u> in the following areas of the **Dog Salmon Flats** Section:

- To the ADF&G markers located at the stream termini of **Dog Salmon Creek** (stream #257-403); and,
- To the ADF&G markers located near **Horse Marine Lagoon** (stream #257-402).

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350).
