**KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT #46
For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-46-18**

The **Izhut Bay** and **Outer Kitoi Bay** sections of the **Afognak District** will close to commercial salmon fishing at **6:00 p.m. Thursday, September 13.**

As Previously Announced:

The **Inner Karluk Section** of the **Southwest Kodiak District** will remain open to commercial salmon fishing until **6:00 p.m. Sunday, September 16.** Closed waters will remain as described in regulation.

There will be a **54-hour** commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Friday, September 14 to 6:00 p.m. Sunday, September 16** in the following areas:

- The **Humpy-Deadman Section** of the **Alitak District**;
- The **Outer Ayakulik Section** of the **Southwest Kodiak District**;
- The **Uyak Bay, Zachar Bay, Spiridon Bay, Inner Uganik Bay, Terror Bay, Kizhuyak Bay, Sharatin Bay, and Anton Larsen Bay** sections of the **Northwest Kodiak District**;
- The **Southeast Afognak, Northwest Afognak, Raspberry Strait, Shuyak Island, Pauls Bay, Perenosa Bay, and Northeast Afognak** sections of the **Afognak District**;
- The **Big River** and **Hallo Bay** sections of the **Mainland District**; and,
- The **Eastside Kodiak District.**

The following areas will remain **open** to commercial salmon fishing **until further notice:**

- The **Outer Karluk, Halibut Bay, and Sturgeon** sections of the **Southwest Kodiak District**;
- The **Central and North Cape** sections of the **Northwest Kodiak District**;
- The **Duck Bay and Southwest Afognak** sections of the **Afognak District**; and,
- The **Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay** sections of the **Alitak District**.

Until further notice, in that **portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts, south of a latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear** in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350).
