EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the resident and nonresident mountain goat hunting season in the following portions of hunt area RG150; (1) that portion including all drainages west of Silver Bay to Redoubt Bay, Redoubt Lake drainage, all drainages into Crawfish Inlet, and all drainages into Necker Bay (known as the Redoubt Bay-Necker Bay Zone) on Baranof Island in Game Management Unit 4. This emergency order takes effect at 11:59 PM, September 29, 2011.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the provisions of **5 AAC 85.040**, **Hunting seasons and bag limits for goat**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

JUSTIFICATION:

Biologists have set a maximum guideline harvest objective of 6 males or 1 female goat allowed for that portion of Unit 4 (RG150) including that portion of the Redoubt Bay –Necker Bay Zone (all drainages west of Silver Bay to Redoubt Bay, Redoubt Lake drainage, all drainages into Crawfish Inlet, and all drainages into Necker Bay) on Baranof Island. As of Tuesday, September 27, 2011, three female goats have been reported harvested. Because the guideline harvest has been met in this area, an emergency order is being issued to close the mountain goat hunting season at 11:59 pm, Thursday, September 29, 2011. The emergency order action is necessary to restrict the harvest to the guideline level, and to prevent overharvest in this area. Any additional harvest could have long-term negative effects on this goat population.
