JUSTIFICATION:

Based on survey information collected in 2010 and 2011, a guideline harvest of 4 points (male goat=1 point & female goat=2 points) was established for the area south of the Katzehin River to Yeldadalga Creek. As of Thursday, December 1, 2011 the reported harvest is 2 female goats and 2 male goats for a total of 6 points. Given that the guideline harvest has been exceeded in this area, and that mountain goats are extremely vulnerable in the area to boat based hunting during winter months, managers consider it necessary to close the hunting season to prevent the additional harvest of any mountain goats.
