# Hunting and Trapping Emergency Order <br> Under the Authority of AS 16.05.060 <br> Alaska Department of Fish and Game 

Emergency Order No. 04-02-12
Issued at Palmer, Alaska July 24, 2012

Effective Date: 12:01 AM August 1, 2012
Expiration Date: June 30, 2013 unless superseded by subsequent emergency order

## EXPLANATION:

This emergency order reduces the length of the lynx hunting and trapping season in Game Management Unit 14A, 14B and 16. The adjusted season dates are published in the 2012-13 Hunting Regulations and in the 2012-13 Trapping Regulations and conform to the lynx season dates offered in the affected Units during regulatory years 2006 through 2011.

## REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 84.270(5) and 5AAC 85.60(4), Furbearer Trapping and Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Lynx, are superseded by this emergency order and the following provisions are in effect for the 2012-13 regulatory year:

## JUSTIFICATION:

Lynx are considered scarce in Units $14 \mathrm{~A}, 14 \mathrm{~B}$, and 16, and the population size has not increased during the last 20 years. During regulatory years 2006-2011 the Department shortened the lynx trapping season due to concerns that the lynx population might be adversely affected by overharvest if trapping and hunting pressure was not reduced. The Department does not currently have any new information to suggest that the population size has increased. As a result a longer trapping or hunting season cannot be justified at this time.
