ADF&G Extends Resident Moose Hunt in Remainder of GMU 22A

NOME –The Department of Fish and Game announces a season extension of the moose hunting season in the following area: Unit 22A Remainder. The resident moose season with a bag limit of one antlered bull will open Feb. 11- Feb. 29. The bag limit is intended to prevent cow harvest which may limit herd growth and better moose hunting opportunity in future years. Allowing additional hunting opportunity through the end of February will accommodate periods of inclement weather that prevented hunting activity when data suggest additional bull harvest is sustainable at this time.

The Remainder of Unit 22A includes the Golsovia River drainage and all drainages south to the Pastoliak River drainage. Please note that if a person has harvested a moose in the fall 2011 or winter 2012 season they are not eligible to harvest a moose in this extended season.

Note: Moose seasons in all other portions of Unit 22 are unchanged at this time, and the extended resident moose hunting season (Feb. 11- Feb. 29 with a bag limit of 1 antlered bull) only applies to "Unit 22A remainder".
