### **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order changes the bag limit for all state Nelchina caribou hunts in Game Management Unit 13 from either sex to bull-only on August 11. Caribou hunters with Copper Basin Community Subsistence Harvest permits (CC001) and Tier I Subsistence permits (RC566) will be allowed to harvest either-sex caribou for one day, August 10, before the bag limit changes to bull-only for the remainder of the season. The drawing permit hunts (DC480-DC483) will open August 20 with a bull-only bag limit. This emergency order does not affect any other caribou hunting regulation in Unit 13.

### **REGULATION:**

Therefore, the provisions of **5AAC 85.025** (a) (8), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Caribou**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

1 **<u>bull</u>** every regulatory year by drawing permit; up to 5,000 permits may be issued

All other caribou hunting regulations remain unchanged and are not affected by this emergency order.

## **JUSTIFICATION:**

To maintain the population objective of 35,000-40,000 Nelchina caribou, harvest quotas are modified annually. The harvest objective for the Nelchina caribou herd for the 2013-2014 season is 2,500 caribou (2,200 bulls and 300 cows). It is anticipated that the cow harvest on August 10 under state subsistence permit hunts in combination with cows taken under federal subsistence permits will be sufficient to achieve this year's cow quota.
