MOOSE HUNTING SEASON CLOSURE UNIT 5A WEST OF THE DANGEROUS RIVER

(Juneau) – Alaska Department of Fish and Game and United States Forest Service biologists announce an early closure to the moose hunting season in that portion of the RM061 permit area in Game Management Unit 5(A) that lies west of the Dangerous River. The hunt in this area is managed under joint state and federal registration permit RM061.

The Department of Fish & Game set a harvest objective of 25 bull moose for this area. As of Thursday afternoon, October 24, 2013, the harvest had reached 23 bulls; the harvest is expected to reach or exceed the 25 bull moose harvest objective in the next few days. In order to maintain adequate bull to cow moose ratios by not overharvesting bull moose an Emergency Order (01-10-13) was issued that closes the moose hunting season in this area on Saturday, October 26, 2013 @ 11:59 pm.

Hunters are reminded that the remainder of Game Management Unit 5A east of the Dangerous River will remain open for moose hunting through the 15th of November or until the overall harvest of bull moose on the Yakutat Forelands reaches 55 bulls.
