## **Twentymile Drainage Registration Goat Hunt Closes**

(Anchorage) – Registration permit hunt RG862 for mountain goats in the Twentymile drainage will close at one minute before midnight on November 13, 2013, by emergency order of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game.

Anchorage Area Wildlife Biologist Jessy Coltrane said the quota of nine "mountain goat units" has been harvested from the Twentymile area. The take of no more than nine goat units is consistent with the goal of maintaining desired population levels in this hunt area. Total goat units are calculated using one unit for billies and two for nannies. To date five billies and two nannies (nine goat units) have been harvested.

All other goat hunts in Game Management Unit 14C are unaffected by the emergency order.
