EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state registration permit hunt RM164 for antlered moose in Game Management Unit 6(B). All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 6 are unaffected by this emergency order.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 85.045(4)**, **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 6 remain unchanged and are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

The most recent population point estimate for 6B, east of the Copper River Delta and including the Martin River Valley, is 227 moose (90% CI 177-278). The Department set a maximum allowable harvest of 20 bulls. The current harvest is 20 bulls and hunters are currently in the field. In order to prevent over-harvest, RM164 will be closed on 20 September 2014 at 12:00 noon.
