#### **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order closes the resident and nonresident goat hunting seasons between the Kicking Horse River/ Garrison Glacier south to the Sullivan River (Unit 1C border) in Game Management Unit 1D. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Thursday September 8, 2016.

#### **REGULATORY TEXT:**

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting goat in Unit 1(D):

The remainder of Unit 1D mountain goat seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

#### JUSTIFICATION:

Based on survey information, a combined guideline harvest objective of 1-2 points (male goats=1 point, female goats=2 points) was established by ADF&G for the portion of Unit 1(D) between the Kicking Horse River/ Garrison Glacier south to the Sullivan River (Unit 1 (C) border). As of Tuesday, September 6, 2016 1 male goat has been taken in this area for a total of 1 point. Due to the vulnerability of goats in this area, and because the guideline harvest level has been reached an emergency order has been issued to close the mountain goat hunting season in the area described above at **11:59 pm on Thursday**, **September 8, 2016**. Those portions of Unit 1(D) not affected by this emergency order, and not previously closed by emergency order, will remain open until the harvest guidelines are reached or the seasons come to their scheduled conclusions.
