# Hunting and Trapping Emergency Order 

## EXPLANATION:

This Emergency Order closes the State of Alaska resident hunting season in the Unit 18 Kuskokwim Area hunt area. This area includes the Lower Kuskokwim River drainage where the hunting season for antlered bull moose by registration permit RM615 on State Land closes at 11:59 p.m. on September 5, 2016. Based on harvest reports received to date, the harvest quota of 150 antlered bull moose will be reached by the closing date in this announcement and no further harvest is warranted. All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 18 remain unchanged by this emergency order.

## REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5 AAC 85.045 (a) (16), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR MOOSE are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose in Unit 18.

of the east bank of Crooked Creek, then continuing upriver along the east bank of Crooked Creek to the outlet at Arhymot Lake, then following the south bank of Arhymot
Lake easterly to the Unit 18
boundary, and north of and including the Eek River drainage.

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 18 remain unchanged by this emergency order.


## JUSTIFICATION:

The Alaska Board of Game established a registration permit hunt for antlered bull moose in the Unit 18 Kuskokwim Area hunt area. The moose population in this portion of Unit 18 is estimated at approximately 1900 moose and a harvest quota of 150 antlered bull moose on State Managed Lands has been established by the department to prevent overharvest of bulls. Hunting began on September 1 and harvest rates show that the harvest quota of 150 antlered bulls will be reached by September 5, 2016. Unsuccessful hunters and hunters that did not hunt need to report by September 25, 2016.
