Redoubt Bay – Necker Bay Zone Closed to Mountain Goat Hunting

(Sitka) - Biologists have set a maximum guideline harvest objective of 6 male goats and/or one female goat from the Redoubt Bay – Necker Bay Zone portion of the Unit 4 registration goat hunt (RG150). As of October 10, 2016, 6 male goats have been reported harvested. Because the guideline harvest has been met in this area, an emergency order is being issued to close the mountain goat hunting

season at 11:59 pm, October 11, 2016. This emergency order is necessary to restrict the harvest to the guideline level, and to prevent overharvest in this area. Any additional harvest could have long-term negative effects on this goat population.

Emergency Order (01-16-16) was issued to close the mountain goat season in this area on October 11, 2016 @ 11:59 pm.

Those portions of Unit 4 not affected by this emergency order, and not previously closed by emergency order, will remain open until harvest guidelines are reached or the season concludes. For more information, contact the Sitka Area Wildlife Office at (907) 747-5449.
