Permits for Kenai Peninsula Registration Goat Hunts RG364, RG365 Available July 13

(Homer) – Permits for mountain goat registration hunts RG364 and RG365 in Game Management Unit 15 will be available starting July 13 in the local communities. Permits for RG364 will be distributed in Seldovia at 9:45 a.m. at the library multipurpose room. Permits for RG365 will be available in Port Graham from the Tribal Council Office and in Nanwalek from the IRA Council.

Permits must be picked up in person and will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis.

RG364 is open to Alaska residents only. Twenty permits will be issued for the hunt. This is an increase of five permits over the previous season.

RG365 is open to Alaska resident and nonresident hunters. Thirty permits will be issued for the hunt, 15 each from Port Graham and Nanwalek.
