Unit 17C portion of the Winter Moose Hunt (RM585) Closes

(DILLINGHAM) – The Unit 17C portion of winter registration permit moose hunt RM585 will close by emergency order on Sunday, December 10, 2017, at 11:59 p.m.

Composition surveys indicate the Unit 17C bull:cow ratio is currently well below the minimum biologists try to manage for, post-hunting season. With eight moose already reported taken and approximately 240 permits issued, additional moose will likely be harvested prior to the closure.

Relatively good snowmachine travel conditions this year have increased the RM585 hunt's popularity, and biologists believe closing the hunting season is necessary to prevent further overharvest of bulls in Unit 17C. Incomplete harvest reporting has also added uncertainty for managers working to tally the harvest for inseason management of this hunt.
