EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state registration permit hunt RM164 for antlered moose in Game Management Unit 6(B). All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 6 are unaffected by this emergency order.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 85.045(4)**, **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

JUSTIFICATION:

The 2018 moose population point estimate for Unit 6B, east of the Copper River Delta and including the Martin River Valley, is 420 moose (90% CI 320-520). The department set a maximum allowable harvest of 28 bulls. The current harvest is 28 bulls and hunters are currently in the field. In order to prevent overharvest, RM164 will be closed on 26 September 2018 at 11:59 p.m.
