EXPLANATION:

Hunting seasons for wolves in Game Management Unit 20C west of the Savage River and bounded by Denali National Park and Preserve will close at 11:59 p.m. on Monday, April 02, 2018. Trapping seasons for wolves in Game Management Unit 20C west of the Savage River and bounded by Denali National Park and Preserve will close at 11:59 p.m. on Monday, April 09, 2018.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.056(a)(2), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR WOLVES, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting wolves:

All other wolf hunting and trapping regulations are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

The wolf harvest this season in the area described is more than the past 5-year average and there is the potential for more harvest to occur before the end of the regulatory hunting and trapping seasons. This wolf harvest closure is done in an effort to manage harvest closer to the previous 5-year average.

The hunting season for wolves in this area was scheduled to end by regulation on April 15, and trapping season was scheduled to end by regulation on April 30. There are no conservation concerns for wolves in Game Management Unit 20C, which includes a large portion of the park.
