

EXPLANATION:

Hunting seasons for wolves in Game Management Unit 20C within the townships in the Stampede corridor area bounded by Denali National Park and Preserve will close on Monday, April 2, 2018. Trapping seasons for wolves in Game Management Unit 20C within the townships in the Stampede corridor area bounded by Denali National Park and Preserve will close on Monday, April 9, 2018.



REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.056(a)(2), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR WOLVES, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting wolves:

All other wolf hunting and trapping regulations are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

The wolf harvest this season in the area described is more than the past 5-year average and there is the potential for more harvest to occur between now and the end of the hunting and trapping seasons. This wolf harvest closure is done in an effort to manage harvest closer to the previous 5-year average.

The normal hunting season for wolves ends on April 15 in this area and trapping ends April 30. There are no conservation concerns for wolves in Game Management Unit 20C, which includes a large portion of the park.
