## State Extends Moose Hunt in Unit 22A North (Shaktoolik Area)

(Nome) – The Alaska department of Fish and Game announces an Emergency Order extension of the resident moose season in Unit 22(A), that portion north of and including the Tagoomenik and Shaktoolik River drainages. The State resident season for bull moose will be extended starting October 4, 2018 at 12:01am through October 10, 2018 at 11:59pm. Current harvest within the area is below the estimated sustainable harvest level. The extension is expected to increase opportunity for hunters but not increase harvest beyond what is sustainable for the area.

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 22 remain unchanged by this emergency order.
