EXPLANATION:

This emergency order opens all hunting in that portion of GMU 14A closed by emergency order 04-04-19. This action is intended to compliment the Department of Natural Resources public order in the Deshka Landing Fire Area. All remaining hunting seasons are open to coincide with the hunting regulation book.

JUSTIFICATION:

On August 23 the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry restricted access in an area associated with active fire suppression for the Deshka Landing Fire Area. Emergency vehicles and many fire personnel are throughout this area and hunters are requested to stay out of the area until further notice. The Department of Fish and Game was requested to close hunting in this area and notify hunters of this closure. Hunters were advised of this closure and that it was temporary. The hunting closure has been lifted by EO, restoring hunting seasons and bag limits in this area, and coincides with Department of Natural Resources' public order to reopen the area on September 11, 2019.
