This emergency order closes the state registration permit hunt RM160 for bull moose in the western portion of Game Management Unit 6(A). All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 6 are unaffected by this emergency order.

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 85.045(4)**, **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

JUSTIFICATION:

The 2020 moose population point estimate for Unit 6A West, drainages between Cape Suckling to Palm Point, is 200 moose (90% CI 117-292). The department set a maximum allowable harvest of 15 bulls for the registration hunt (RM160). The current registration harvest is 15 bulls and hunters currently remain in the field. To prevent overharvest, RM160 will be closed on September 15, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.
