EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the State of Alaska nonresident black and brown bear seasons in Game Management Units 1-26. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Thursday, April 2, 2020, and is effective through 11:59 pm, May 31, 2020 unless superseded by additional emergency orders.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5 AAC 85.015 (a), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR BLACK BEAR; and 5 AAC 85.020 (a), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR BROWN BEAR are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting black and brown bears.

This emergency order is limited to nonresident black and brown bear hunts in Game Management Units 1-26 only. For the safety of Alaska's communities, and especially individuals most vulnerable to the COVID-19 virus, Commissioner of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game Doug Vincent-Lang has directed the Division of Wildlife Conservation to close all black and brown bear hunts statewide for nonresident hunters, effective now through May 31. This decision will be reevaluated as necessary. All resident black and brown bear seasons remain unchanged. Hunters are reminded to familiarize themselves with health related travel restrictions mandated by the State of Alaska at http://dhss.alaska.gov/Pages/default.aspx.
