ADF&G announces temporary ability to register bear bait stations remotely for Spring 2020

(STATEWIDE) – The Alaska Department of Fish and Game encourages the public to register bear bait stations remotely, without coming into offices. Beginning April 1, the public will be able to call local Fish and Game offices to register bait sites and will be emailed or mailed the permit to use bait to take bears. Hunters registering bait stations must verbally agree to the conditions of the permit. Most offices are open from 8am to 5pm Monday through Friday, and a complete list of offices and phone numbers is available at http://www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=contacts.main.

The ability to register bait stations over the phone is a temporary measure and we ask for your patience as we attempt to implement this new procedure. It may take a few days to receive your permit in the mail if you choose to have one mailed to you, so do not wait until the day you intend to head into the field to call. You may not place bait at your site until you have received your permit. For more information on using bait or scent lures to take bears please see pages 26 and 27 of the 2019-2020 Alaska Hunting Regulations, also available at <u>hunt.alaska.gov</u>.
